

CATHOLIC NON-NEGOTIABLES – INTRINSIC EVILS - As far as the Catholic Church is concerned, its principal focus in the public arena is the protection and promotion of the dignity of the person, and she is thereby consciously drawing particular attention to principles which are not negotiable. Among these the following emerge clearly today: (a) protection of life in all its stages, from the first moment of conception until natural death; (b) recognition and promotion of the natural structure of the family as a union between a man and a woman based on marriage, and its defense from attempts to make it juridically equivalent to radically different forms of union which in reality harm it and contribute to its destabilization, obscuring its particular character and its irreplaceable social role; (c) the protection of the right of parents to educate their children. (Pope Benedict XVI, Address to European Parliamentary Group, 30 March 2006)

The Hyde Amendment is named for the late Rep. Henry Hyde (D-IL), who sponsored the amendment that was first enacted in 1976, and which prevents taxpayer funding of abortions except in case of rape or incest. The amendment has passed every year since 1976 as an attachment to spending bills with bipartisan support. It is estimated that the amendment has saved over 2 million lives since its enactment. Democrat President Joe Biden was a long-time supporter of the Hyde Amendment, but last week said he would oppose the Hyde Amendment. Vice-President Kamala Harris and Senator Elizabeth Warren have already opposed the Hyde Amendment. The 2016 Democratic National Platform called for the repeal of the policy as well as of the Helms Amendment, which restricts the U.S. from giving foreign assistance for abortions. Roll Call reported that an amendment was inserted into the Labor-HHS appropriations bill by Reps. Jayapal, Pressley, Lee, DeGette, and Schakowsky that would remove the Hyde Amendment from the package and require federal funding of abortion in Medicaid and other federal health programs, as well as prevent any state or local restrictions on abortion coverage in the private sector. As Catholics, we are to promote, not negate, the sanctity of all life. Please write or call your Representative and Senators to voice your concern that they support the Hyde Amendment and any other bill that removes federal funding from abortion.
